The end-of-the-year Drama Banquet is coming up! The Banquet will take place in on June 1st, beginning at 6:00 pm on the Auditorium Main Stage. The night will include costumes, delicious food, awards, spoof videos, and fun!

This year's theme is Decades! Each class should dress up according to their assigned decade. Seniors are the 50s, Juniors are the 60s, Sophomores and the 70s, and Freshmen are the 80s. Costumes are not required but are encouraged! No costume pieces may be borrowed from the SET costume loft for the Banquet.

Auditions for Fall Shows

Auditions for *In The Heights* and *Allocating Annie* will be Friday, June 7th from 1:30-6:30 and Saturday, June 8th from 1:00-4:00. Please arrive promptly and head to the Little Theater behind the main Auditorium stage. Incoming freshmen may arrive after their school day is over and will be able to leave early for evening graduation events.

In The Heights will be directed by our drama teacher Pat Avery. Performances will take place in the month of November. There will be six performances. Please make sure you are available during next November and after school on weekdays for rehearsal before auditioning.

The majority of singing auditions will take place on Friday. Please prepare a 1-minute cut of a song from *In The Heights*. Piano accompaniment will be provided, and you must sing with the provided accompanist. A short selec-

tion will be taught at the audition for those unable to prepare a song.

Dance auditions will take place both days with our choreographer Laura Hiszczyński. Please be prepared with shoes and clothes you can dance in on both days.

Allocating Annie will be directed by senior Alex Shonk. Performances will be in October. Please make sure you are available during October and after school on weekdays for rehearsal before auditioning.

Auditions for the play happen simultaneously with the auditions for the musical. If you are a non-musical actor, you are not required to audition for the musical as well. However, those wishing to audition for *In The Heights* must audition for *Allocating Annie* as well.

show will be posted on the South Eugene Theater Facebook page and on the callboard outside side of the Little Theater on the morning of Monday, June 10th. Callbacks will take place Monday, June 10th at 1:00. Callbacks can run long so be prepared to stay as long as you are needed.

Auditioning is tacit acceptance of any part you are offered in either show. Please check to make sure you are available for rehearsals and performances before you audition.
